Registration Begins For March 28 Electronics Recycling Event! Must Pre-Register to Participate

DENVER, CO – Gather up your old broken down televisions, computers and other electronic items and get them recycled at no charge at Denver's Electronics Recycling Collection Event on Saturday, March 28.

Pre-registration is easy! Go online to <u>mar28-ecycle.eventbrite.com</u> and choose your appointment time slot. This free-of-charge collection event will take place on Saturday, March 28 from 9:00am to 3:00pm at East High School in the football field parking lot at 1650 Josephine Street. The event is open to all Colorado residents. No commercial or business recycling.

Items Accepted For Recycling: Televisions, monitors, CPUs, laptops, printers, scanners, faxes, keyboards, mice, stereos, external hard drives & storage devices, cellular phones, telephones, DVRs, VCRs, digital cameras, video recorders, MP3 players, video game consoles, wires, cables, rechargeable batteries, and some small appliances such as microwaves.

Items NOT Accepted: Air conditioners, large appliances, vacuum cleaners, car batteries or household batteries.

It's important to recycle unwanted electronics because disposing them in landfills is illegal in the state of Colorado. If you're not able to attend this event, call **311** (720-913-1311) or visit <u>DenverGov.org/Ecycle</u> for more information about other electronic recycling options.
